

There are plenty of dangerous jobs in the world but as most people and they wouldn't say journalist is one of them. To be a good journalist however whether with a camera or keyboard or paper and pencil, you have to expose yourself to people, ideas, events and sometimes risk. You've probably heard of Wall Street Journal reporter Daniel Pearl and NBC's David Bloom. Pearl disappeared in January 2002, Bloom died in April 2003. In that 15 months period, around the world, 46 journalists died in the line of duty. They died trying to do their jobs. These are the stories of 6 extraordinary individuals, most of whom you probably never heard about but they are men and women whose dedication and sacrifice you will not soon forget.
