So we can ask the following question: "...?" > question directe: Wh + Aux + S + V!

Start your question with : How / To what extent / Should ... ?



• Choisissez votre angle: obstacles vs limits /// today's reality / future problems...



- Dans votre développement : Comparez vos exemples
 ("On one hand ... but on the other hand ... ")
- Mentionnez vos documents / trouvez des points communs et des différences.



• En conclusion, répondez à votre problématique et évoquez votre point de vue personnel.

- What is progress for you? What types of progress can you think of?
- What is the most important form of progress for you?
- Are you addicted to new technologies?
- What do you do online? What's your favourite app? Video game? Why?
- Do you think teachers will be replaced by computers one day?

B1

- Have you experienced any form of progress in your life (recently)?
- Do you think the Internet and new technologies best represent progress? Why?
- What is the difference between online tutorials and school?

B2

- In what way has progress made life better, faster, stronger ? Can you give any examples?
- Do you think that progress is always positive? Can there be a negative side to progress?
- What is the darkest or most controversial invention?
- What do you think are the most important / useful inventions of the past 50 years?
- How has the Internet changed today's world?
- Would you like to be able to travel in time? Back when or where?
- What are the pros and cons of online learning?

C1

- In your opinion, what was the major technological or scientific breakthrough in the last decades?
- Do you think people were happier before or now? What do you miss from the past?
 What do you think is better now?
- Most Western European people describe their society as 'advanced' or 'developed' do you agree? How could this vision be questioned?
- Are we really moving forward or backward? Can you give an example?
- Could you give examples of advances/ innovations that led to a hot debate/ that set people apart?
- Do you understand technophobes? How do you feel about cutting- edge technology yourself?
- What do you miss the most from when you were young? Why?
- Have you noticed anything from your childhood disappear from the supermarket?
- What things of the past would you have liked to know? See? Use?
- Do you think your grandmother was happier than you at your age?
